Player Code of Conduct



I (write name here), as a member of Napier City Rovers AFC, will always conduct myself in a manner to the following standard and I agree to :

1. Observe and play within the laws of the game as well as respecting opponents, team mates, referees, officials and spectators.
2. Train and play to the best of my ability, have a positive attitude and encourage others to do the same.
3. Display self control in all situations and not enter into violent conduct, serious foul play, threatening, abusive, indecent or insulting words or behaviour towards others, including, but not limited to, officials/referees, own team and opposition players, coaches, spectators at any time before, during or after a match or training session.
4. Not steal or take items that do not belong to me.
5. Pay for the cost of replacement or repair of any item broken, if guilty and responsible for breaking such item in a reckless, unreasonable or uncontrollable manner.
6. Wear issued gear and strip and to return all the gear and strip given to me back to Napier City Rovers, at end of the season or if I leave the club beforehand.
7. Not act in any way that may bring disrepute or disgrace to Napier City Rovers, other club members, Napier City Rovers stakeholders and/or Napier City Rovers sponsors or commercial partners by ensuring the absence of any conduct, behaviour or statement which materially injures the reputation and goodwill of Napier City Rovers generally.
8. Not to provide comment to any media on behalf of Napier City Rovers.
9. Represent Napier City Rovers AFC with pride and dignity.
10. To fulfil all financial obligations, including all fines/fees I incur from Central Football and understand failure to do so will affect eligibility to play for the club or to be transferred to any other club.

PENALTIES:

Player/Club Expectations



Player Expectations:

As a player with Napier City Rovers you may expect the following:

1. All appropriate equipment - nets, pegs, corner flags, first aid kit, training cones and bibs to be provided for each Napier City Rovers team. This includes playing strip of shirt, shorts and socks.
2. Membership benefits as per your membership card.
3. To play at the highest level depending on personal ability.
4. Coaching by qualified coaches where possible.

Club Expectations:

As a representative of Napier City Rovers the Club may expect of you the following:

1. To abide by the Player Code of Conduct
2. To support the Club on home game days and at any fund raising or social functions.
3. To be available to play/represent Napier City Rovers in any division throughout the Club as and when required, within reason and the rules and regulations of Central Football.
4. To fulfil financial obligations. Failure to do so will effect eligibilty to play for the Club or to be transferred to any other club. (No non-financial player can be granted a transfer to any other club)
